- There would be a Civil War battle re-enactment over the Bank Holiday weekend at Flood Meadows, and other Living History events taking place throughout the town all weekend.
- There was a “sweet soul Sunday” planned at the Railway Arms on the bank holiday Sunday. A local charity was being sought to benefit from the proceeds.
- Waitrose had a meeting room that could be used free of charge by local community groups.
- Thanks was made to the Town Council for the Walk day they organised.
- Stinging Nettles were overgrowing at Edward Road.
- At Accentors Close and around the Gentleman Jim pub there was foliage overgrowing boundaries.
