Rat Run: Anstey Park internal
road frequently becomes rat run

Significant and frequent vehicle movement and
on-street parking: Seasonal regular football,
rugby and cricket matches, traffic of which
regularly exceeds available parking in Anstey Park

Significant and frequent
vehicle movements:
Anstey Park based
organisations, including
Alton United Youth
Football Club, Alton Royal
British Legion, Alton Air
Cadets and Alton Army
Cadets, 8th Alton Scouts,
Alton Rugby Club, Energique
Health Club and Spa and
St John Ambulance

Major route junction from East

Significant and frequent vehicle movement and
on-street parking: Cedar Veterinary Group

ST Swithuns Way historic footpath
