Bus route

Large amount of residential on-street parking

Major crossing point:
Access to Wooteys Infant and Junior schools

Significant and frequent vehicle movements:
Garden House Day Nursery

Significant and frequent vehicle movements:
Alton Convent School, the majority of the 700 pupils are dropped by private car

Significant and frequent vehicle movements:
Tesco Express HGV deliveries manoeuvring plus customer on-street parking

Rat Run: Ansteley Park internal road frequently becomes rat run

Significant and frequent vehicle movement and on-street parking:
Seasonal regular football, rugby and cricket matches, traffic of which regularly exceeds available parking in Ansteley Park

Significant and frequent vehicle movements:
Ansteley Park based organisations, including Alton United Youth Football Club, Alton Royal British Legion, Alton Air Cadets and Alton Army Cadets, 8th Alton Scouts, Alton Rugby Club, Energique Health Club and Spa and St John Ambulance

Major route junction from East to Alton College Car Park

No pavement

Significant and frequent vehicle movement and on-street parking:
Cedar Veterinary Group

ST Swithuns Way historic footpath

Already over burdened junction at peak times with regular back-up beyond park entrance
